Step 2 – (Completed by Law Firm)



- A portal to be used by the company and all law firms to instruct/brief firms on individual matters.
- The portal is to include detailed matter plans and budgets.
- Company should require additional signing authority, depending on matter thresholds.



- Ensure ISP/RFP requires firms to document this capability.
- Train all in-house counsel to use the portal and the ROI.

Linking Legal Project Management and AFAs

- Estimate work volumes by category of law and region
- Estimate annual variations if at least 10% for the ISP/RFP Scope of Work



Project Management & Process Improvement

The discipline of managing resources (people and technology) to bring about the successful completion of the specific goals of a legal matter (goals as carefully determined by the client) while honoring the constraints of the matter (such as time, money and the current state of the law).

Linking LPM and AFAs

- Legal project management and budgets for all matters requiring more than 50 hours.
- Essential to control total hours and staffing ratios.
- Improves likelihood of respecting
 - Blended rates for hourly billing arrangements.
 - Total hours and collar for fixed fee arrangements



Linking LPM and AFAs

Detailed matter budget includes

- Hours by phase and task
- Planning assumptions by task
- 85 % certainty for planning assumptions
- Hours by timekeeper
- Total fees by phase and task
- Blended rate by phase and matter

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Sample Trial Budget





- Calculate projected legal spend for reference period (e.g. 2020-2022) using current year baseline rates from historical data or from the Request for Information (RFI).
- Build in average annual rate increases as reported by firms in the RFI.



- Projected legal spend should be by region and by category of law.
- Provisional legal spend should be based on a provisional allocation of work volumes to panel firms



Panel should cost 20% less than projected legal spend, on average.



Transitions



Transitions

- Experience proves that companies will take 6-12 months to transition to new arrangements and new allocations.
- A 1-month transition should suffice.
- Stop assigning work to non-panel firms 6 months before effective date.



Transitions

- CLO / General Counsel must oversee the transition program personally.
- Law firms can assist with this transition by
 - Appointing a project manager
 - Providing internal training to CRMs
 - Collaborating with client on technology
 - Undertaking regular reviews
